Booking Process for Members

Currently the key is located at Martin Parmenter's House (Secretary) Unit 1 / 2 Headlands Avenue, directly opposite the courts. Chloe the black lab may bark a bit but she won't bite – she just loves a pat. The key is behind the right hand side upright.

At this stage we ask financial members to collect and return the key just as you did with lan over the years. In future, we will have an on-line system that will allow members to over-ride 'court hire fees'. For now, just check the calendar and if your time slot is available, pick up the key and play. We feel it unlikely that members who turn up to play will then find that both courts have suddenly been booked by casuals. We ask that, should this happen, that you are gratious enough to let our paying guests play as it would be an extremely time consuming process for your volunteer steering committee to refund them. If they are hotel guests staying at Headies, then it is ok to ask them to wait or perhaps join you for doubles!

Headies gave the club \$8000 3 years ago as sponsorship / contra for ad hoc court usage for their guests which is valid till December 31st this year.
